3. Art to be mounted on Poster Board, NOT TO EXCEED 11” x 14” size to allow a border for stapling. NO Frames! NO Hanging devices!
4. All items must have been made within the last year and may not have been exhibited before at the Gibson County Fair.
5. No entries will be accepted unless they are listed.
6. Entries accepted in three groups: 1st - 3rd grade; 4th -6th grade; 7th grade & up.
