## Exhibitor General Information & Rules:

**Entry Times:** Saturday, August 23rd and Sunday, August 24th, 1-5 pm.  
Monday, August 25th, 8-10 am Culinary, cut flowers, and floral design only.  
Culinary will be accepted on Sunday and Monday ONLY.

**Release Time:** Sunday, August 31st, 1-4 pm.  
Items not picked up on this date are subject to disposal.

### **General Rules:**

1. Exhibitor must have entry form completed when entering items. It is located on page 11.
2. All articles must be listed in owner's name and by lot number.
3. Products must be made by the person in whose name it is entered.
4. No entries accepted unless they are listed in catalogue.
5. No article may have been exhibited before at the Gibson County Fair.
6. Items must have been completed since last year's fair
7. Exhibitor must be a resident of Gibson, Crockett, or Weakley Counties or members of Gibson County FCE.
8. Exhibitors may exhibit **ONLY** one article in any one lot.
9. All articles exhibited are at owner's risk, but reasonable precautions will be taken for the protection of the exhibits.
10. In cases of only one exhibit in a lot, judges shall award one premium, which may be either 1st, 2nd, or 3rd.
11. The judges shall be instructed not to award ribbons to articles not worthy of merit or to articles borrowed or purchased for competition, or those incorrectly entered.
12. Best of Show will be chosen from blue ribbon winners in the following categories: Canning, Clothing & Needlework, Crafts, Culinary, Quilts, Crops, Vegetables & Fruit, Gourds Melons and Potatoes, Horticulture, and Photography.
13. Fair results will not be given on the telephone.
14. Youth may enter exhibits in adult competitions if there is no corresponding youth lot, but adults may not enter in youth competitions.
